Notice is hereby given that at a regular meeting of the board of trustees of the village of Fonda, held on the 23rd day of April, 1928, all members being present, the following village ordinance was duly and regularly adopted and passed:

It is hereby declared to be, and shall be, unlawful for any person or persons, who own or have in his or their possession any poultry within the corporate limits of the village of Fonda, to cause, authorize or permit the same to run at large, or to keep or harbor any poultry on his or their premises unless confined thereon in such manner that the same cannot escape therefrom onto the adjoining or adjacent premises or the streets or public grounds.

Any person or persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall forfeit and pay a penalty or fine of no more than \$5.00 for each offense and a violation thereof shall constitute disorderly conduct, and such person shall be a disorderly person.
