

Notice Of Adoption Of Local Law No. 1  
Of The Village Of Fonda,  
New York

**TAKE NOTICE**, that after a public hearing duly held on July 31, 1978, by resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fonda, New York, dated July 31, 1978. Local Law No. 1 of the Village of Fonda, New York, for the year 1978 was duly adopted and approved; that the following is a true copy of such Local Law No. 1 as adopted:

**Village Of Fonda, New York  
Local Law No. 1 of the year 1978**

A Local law Authorizing the Town Clerk of the Town of Mohawk, Montgomery County, New York, to Issue Licenses For Authorized Games of Chance in the Village of Fonda, New York.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fonda, New York, as follows:

**Section 1.** The town clerk of the Town of Mohawk may issue a permit for the conducting of games of chance in the corporate limits of the Village of Fonda, New York, as authorized by the Constitution of the State of New York and by section 187 of the General Municipal Law. Such permit shall be issued only in accordance with state law and subject to the same conditions or limitations imposed on the conduct of games of chance in the unincorporated area of the town.

**Section 2.** This Local Law shall remain in effect until superseded or repealed as provided in state law and the town clerk shall have the authority granted by this law only so long as the clerk has authority to issue permits in the incorporated area of the Town of Mohawk.

**Section 3.** That this Local law does not take effect until 45 days after its adoption, nor until approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the Village of Fonda voting on a proposition for its approval , if, within 45 days after its adoption, there is filed with the Village Law, protesting against such local law and requiring that it be submitted to the electors of such Village for this approval or disapproval.
