

Local Law No. 2 of the year 1995

Terminating The Village Of Fonda's Status as an assessing unit for the purposes of Real Property Tax purposes.

Section 1. Legislative Intent. The intent of the board of Trustees of the Village of Fonda is to implement Section 1402(3) of the Real Property Tax Law providing for the voluntary termination of the Village's status as an assessing unit, as provided in the Village Law and Real Property Tax Law. It is also the intent of this local law to abolish the position of the Board of Assessors and to terminate any and all responsibility as provided by law for the review of the assessments of real property located within the Village of Fonda.

Section 2. The Village of Fonda shall cease to be an assessing unit on the expiration of thirty days after the adoption of this local law or upon the approval of the electors of the Village in the event permissive referendum is held.

Section 3. The Board of Assessors in the Village of Fonda is hereby abolished.

Section 4. On or after the effective date of this local law, taxes in the Village of Fonda shall be levied on a copy of the applicable part of the assessment roll of the Town of Mohawk with the taxable status date of such Town controlling for village purposes.

Section 5. Within 5 days of the effective date of this local law, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fonda shall file a copy of the local law with the Clerk and Board of Assessors of the Town of Mohawk and with the State Board of Equalization and Assessment.

Section 6. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State, provided, however, that such local law is subject to a permissive referendum and the Village Clerk shall forth proceed to notice such fact and conduct such referendum if required by petition.
